





**W**illard begins by brilliantly challenging the “WWJD?” slogan and suggesting the additional “HWJDI?” that asks, “How would Jesus do it?” That is the point: not just what we do, but how we do it. This leads into Willard’s explanation of servanthood, which powerfully illustrates the way of Jesus in the world. We have to follow a servant God, and make his kingdom, *his way, our way*. It means we give up our self-centered kingdom for God’s kingdom. Often we need to experience exile before we can give up our personal kingdoms for God’s kingdom. Exile is a formative experience because it is in exile that we allow our kingdoms to be torn down.

When we acquaint ourselves with God’s kingdom, we find that the way of this kingdom is servanthood. To
